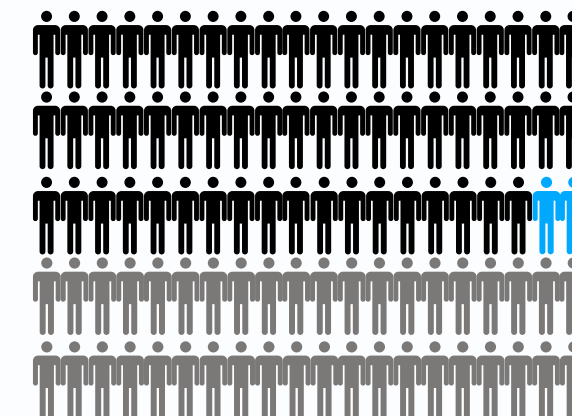




# Opportunity for the Gospel in Mongolia

## Room for Transformation for the Kingdom

Freedom of religion was restored in Mongolia in 1991. According to the 2020 national census, approximately 40% of Mongolians identify as non-religious, with the remaining population mostly identify as Buddhist. In 1989, there were only four known Mongolian Christians. Since 1989, roughly 75,000 Mongolian believers, less than **2% of the population identify as Christian**, including various denominations.



While this growth is encouraging, the number of Christians remains small. ALDN believes the Gospel brings salvation and the power to transform Mongolian society across every sphere—business, culture, government, family, and education. ALDN is dedicated to equipping leaders to drive Christ-centered change.

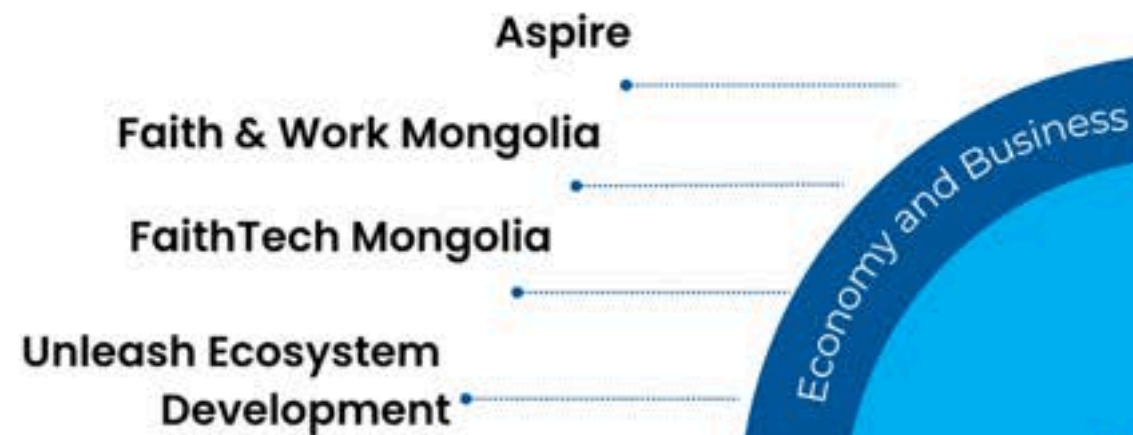

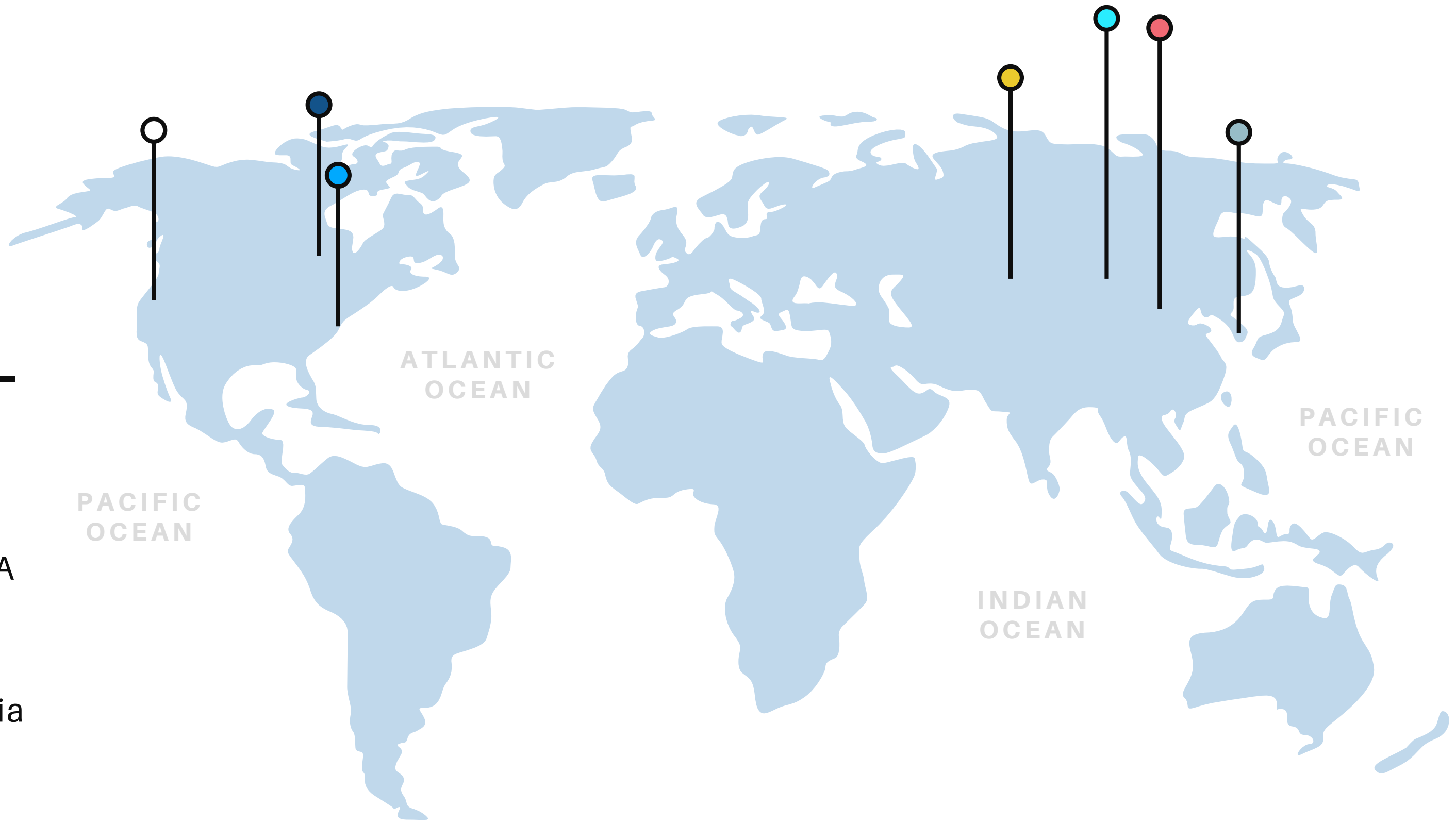

# KINGDOM IMPACT AT WORK

The Faith & Work Entrepreneurship pillar is expressed through two core aspects: **Faith & Work initiatives** and the **Unleash entrepreneurship ecosystem**.

Faith & Work focuses on empowering individuals to integrate their Christian faith into their workplaces, offering resources like Aspire, the FaithTech Mongolian network, and the Faith & Work Mongolia (F&W) initiative, which inspire purpose and societal transformation through vocational excellence and spiritual integration.

The Aspire program nurtured **43 Aspiring Entrepreneurs across 4** in Ulaanbaatar and Washington D.C., with teachings from **16 facilitators and mentors**. Participants honed business skills through exercises, and pitch competitions, and explored early-stage venture lessons, culminating in business initiatives and community proposals. The D.C. cohort showcased diverse ventures, from senior living facilities and comedy shows to handmade embroidery and pastries. Across the 4 global cohorts, each entrepreneur demonstrated creativity, passion, and resilience, reflecting Aspire's impact on their growth.

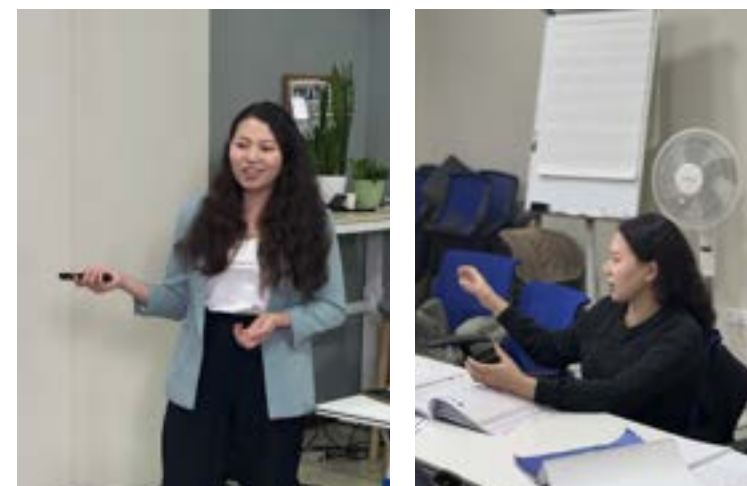

In the Faith & Work Entrepreneurship pillar, the Unleash entrepreneurial ecosystem is dedicated to equipping faith-driven entrepreneurs to create meaningful impact in their communities. We aspire to cultivate vibrant communities, provide leadership training, and connect entrepreneurs with tailored resources and international opportunities, all while championing a God-centered approach to business and societal transformation.

We foster innovation, job creation, and economic growth through initiatives such as the entrepreneurship academy, leadership academy, summit conference, podcast, accelerator program, and global mentor and investor networks. The Unleash ecosystem supports entrepreneurs at various stages of their journey through these varying initiatives.



In 2024, Unleash Academy continued to grow and empower faith-driven entrepreneurs in Mongolia. This year, we **supported 210 entrepreneurs and partnered with 40 mentors**, helping to shape ethical leaders committed to both business success and community impact. We invited global leaders who displayed resilience and excellence to inspire the entrepreneurs.

Unleash produced media content to support entrepreneurs and business leaders, including three Unleash podcast episodes that were aired in collaboration with ALDN's Gerelt Live podcast. The podcast episodes featured personal finance and faith and work discussions. Additionally, Unleash hosted webinars and industry-specific workshops. This content inspires and equips entrepreneurs to lead with integrity and purpose.

# IMPACT BEYOND MONGOLIA

Unleash's impact reaches beyond Mongolia's borders to global Mongolian communities. At the Fourth Lausanne Congress in Seoul, Korea, Unleash Director Oyunbold, mentors Ron and Donna Burdock, a U.S. team member, and 30 Mongolian delegates joined 5,394 believers from over 200 countries to discuss global missions.



The Congress reinforced ALDN's vision and strengthened partnerships. Oyunbold connected with FaithTech leaders and Unleash mentors to explore collaboration opportunities. He noted that ALDN's core pillars—technology in missions, Christ-like servanthood, and justice aligned with key themes.



Marketplace ministry is a focus of ALDN's Unleash initiative, aligning with the Congress theme "God's mission in cities and the workplace." The Workplace Track attracted over 1,400 participants, affirming ALDN's vision for marketplace transformation through Faith and Work Mongolia and Unleash's faith-driven entrepreneurship efforts. Mongolian pastors also stressed the vital role of workplace ministry in Mongolia's spiritual and economic growth.



Faith & Work Mongolia, in collaboration with four other Mongolian ministries, organized a post-Congress forum to discuss actionable next steps for Mongolia. The meeting focused on applying key insights from the Congress and highlighted the increasing importance of workplace ministry.



After the Congress, Oyunbold and the Burdocks hosted an Unleash Seoul event at a Mongolian church in Seoul. Forty attendees expressed gratitude for the gathering and excitement about fostering a stronger community. Ron and Donna shared insights on business and faith, while Pastor Narantuya, a church planter and advocate for Christian entrepreneurs, shared her diverse experiences. The Mongolian Christian community in Korea expressed interest in launching Unleash locally, citing a need for fellowship beyond Sundays amid Korea's fast-paced lifestyle. Inspired by the event, we joined the attendees in envisioning a thriving future community.

# UNLEASH TRANSFORMATION

The Unleash Summit is our flagship annual conference, bringing together thought leaders, entrepreneurs, and volunteers to be encouraged and inspired by faith-driven, purpose-driven entrepreneurship. Since its inception in 2020, we have convened nearly **1,200+** attendees, featuring **69** speakers and **75** volunteers. The summit provides a unique platform for networking, learning, and collaboration. Business leaders and entrepreneurs in our community convene to rethink their whys, cultivate their passion in business, and share their leadership and faith stories.

The success of the Unleash Summit experience requires countless hours and effort in preparation across facilitators, speakers, and day-of volunteers. Over **50** individuals attended pre- and post-debrief meetings in Darkhan and Ulaanbaatar to ensure fruitful delivery and to review lessons learned.

# LEAD WELL

The leadership development pillar is expressed through four core initiatives: Ashid Manlailal, Serve & Lead, City to City, and Global Mentorship partnership with Resource Global.

Ashid Manlailal equips Inner Mongolians in China to lead balanced, impactful lives. By sharing value-driven leadership insights, personal development and entrepreneurship resources, the program fosters growth, time stewardship, and transformation for individual empowerment. These include one-on-one coaching and consulting, developing planner products and media content, and hosting marriage and financial coaching workshops.

## A Coach's Love, A Student's Renewal

*In Inner Mongolia, Ashid Manlailal coaching consultation is gently leading Mongolian children towards hope and light.*

Wu, a high school senior from rural Inner Mongolia, scored just 29% on her college entrance exam, and after having tried for a length of time, her teacher gave up on her. Ashid Manlailal's coaching was her glimmer of support. But she lost her mother 3 months before her final test and thus, she fell into despair. In her darkest hour, her coach became a lifeline, offering not only academic support but deep emotional care, helping her break down her overwhelming fears and find hope again. With the coach's encouragement, Wu improved greatly, gaining not just academic strength, but a renewed enthusiasm, seen through her changed demeanor when the coach finally met her in person in the new school year.

## Empowered by Coaching: Ava's New Chapter

*Ashid Manlailal coaching inspires and supports adults to grow personally and courageously pursue development.*

Ava, a woman from a small town in Inner Mongolia, felt stuck in her life and longed for personal growth. After engaging in coaching with Ashid Manlailal's coach, Ava began to uncover new strength and courage. Through coaching, she took bold steps, enrolling in further learning programs, attending workshops, and ultimately moving to a larger city to challenge herself. Ava credits Ashid Manlailal for helping her develop faith, courage, and vision and guiding her through this life-changing transformation.



# SERVANT LEADER

Serve & Lead is a key initiative in the leadership development pillar that aims to connect and build relationships with Christian civic leaders and to collaborate on public service initiatives. Transformation of Mongolia starts with the **building up of Christ-centered servant leaders** who possess vision, character, and competence in the marketplace, in the community, and in the public sphere, so ALDN aims to invest into these leaders.

In 2024, we hosted **four key Mongolian Christian leaders** at the National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, DC. Among the attendees were a parliament member, a Mongolian diplomat to the U.S., and two officials from foreign affairs services.



These connections fostered meaningful fellowship and opened doors for ongoing collaboration. These included **follow-up visits to the Japanese and South Korean Prayer Breakfasts** by Ms. BB and her husband, which continued to strengthen regional ties between like-minded leaders.

This year also brought exciting Kingdom opportunities. Highlights include a **regional water filter project** aiding thousands in Southeast Mongolia, plans to bring a former NBA team for a **basketball mission** with the current national team, and the **upcoming celebration of the Mongolian Basketball League's 30th anniversary** in 2025.

Additionally, plans are underway **to develop a new Christian International School** in Ulaanbaatar with strategic partners.

God's faithfulness continues to inspire us as we embrace these opportunities and trust Him to work through these impactful relationships.



In 2024, we partnered with Resource Global and launched the first Mongolian mentorship cohort as part of our leadership development pillar. This program was created to address a significant lack of Christian mentorship for emerging marketplace leaders in Mongolia.



To meet this need, we partnered with Resource Global and its founder, Tommy Lee, to pilot Mongolia's first cohort to equip young professionals to live out their faith and impact their workplaces and communities.

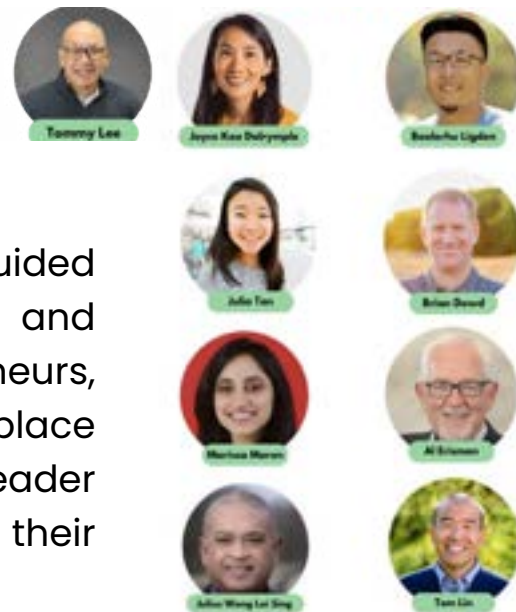

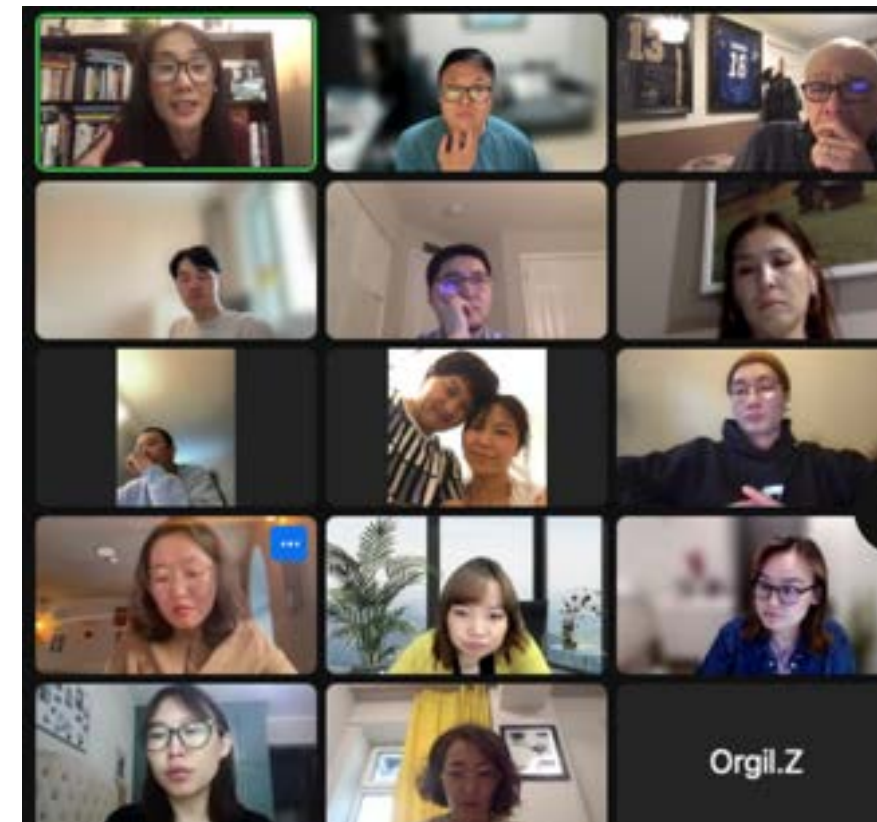
The program brought together 14 exceptional leaders in their 20s and 30s, nominated by trusted mentors across industries for a six-month journey of transformation.

Through virtual sessions, these participants were guided by a diverse team of experienced speakers and mentors—including engineers, artists, entrepreneurs, and civic leaders—on themes of vocation, marketplace ministry, and leadership development. Each leader created a Gospel-driven action plan tailored to their unique season of life.

# CITY TO CITY: CULTIVATING KINGDOM LEADERS

The City to City (CTC) initiative in the leadership development pillar aims to equip and connect leaders to foster Gospel-driven transformation through church planting, urban ministry, leadership development, and discipleship. By cultivating a missional network and encouraging spiritual formation, we aim to renew cities and empower communities for Christ. more future participants.

In 2024, ALDN engaged in two impactful City to City (CTC) initiatives to empower leaders for Gospel-driven transformation.

We connected six pastors to a church planting intensive program, sparking passion for leadership and ministry. One pastor, Pastor Chinzorig, was so inspired that he began leading small groups across Mongolia to encourage and empower others.

Later in the year, we sent two Aspire F&W facilitators to attend the inaugural 2024 CTC Faith & Work Catalyst Intensive for Asia Pacific. The two attendees joined 22 other individuals, representing 11 countries for three days of transformative training. The intensive event convened with the larger two-week 2024 Asia Intensive that covered an array of topics such as gospel renewal, ministry design, evangelistic pathways, and cultural engagement. Attendee Buyanmandakh was even interviewed there as a business owner desiring to expand the Kingdom.

# DELIVERIES OF HOPE, NURTURING FAITH

Mercy Network is the expression of ALDN's mercy and justice pillar. Mercy Network supports vulnerable families in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia through both immediate relief and long-term empowerment.

In 2024, ALDN expanded its impact, serving more families through monthly food deliveries, annual backpack distributions, and pastor training events. We saw 250 people come to faith and increased resilience among those we serve. At a gathering of 36 pastors, many shared how their families transformed from receivers to servants, with some teens returning to serve in children's ministries. We remain committed to supporting families through their physical and emotional challenges.

# Mercy 2.0

## Mercy Community Center

This year, Mercy Network officially initiated plans to expand its impact with the development of the Mercy Community Center. This multi-functional facility will offer child feeding programs, vocational training, and other services designed to transform families' lives. This initiative aims to create lasting change by equipping families with the tools and support to break the cycle of poverty.

### 2021-22: Vision Sparked

Our partnership with Children's Hunger Fund (CHF) began and sparked shared vision to bring hope and transformation to Mongolia's low-income families.

### 2023: Foundation Secured

With faith and generosity and God's provision, we found land fitting the vision and raised \$45,000 to purchase it, a key step toward CHF's larger grant.

### May 2024: Land Blessed

Supporters and leaders from ALDN and CHF visited and prayed over the newly acquired land, dedicating it to God's transformative work.

### Oct 2024: Grant Approved

CHF approved our \$150K grant, enabling us began plans for the center's construction.

### Future: Transformation Begins

The center will offer culinary programs, vocational training, spiritual support, and more, collaborating with the community to uplift Mongolian families.

# GERELT: LIGHT FOR LEARNERS

Gerelt, meaning “bright” or “radiant” in Mongolian, is ALDN’s two-prong initiative aimed at offering learning opportunities and spreading light through Biblical resources. Serving as a beacon of hope, Gerelt reaches Mongolians worldwide with transformative content.

Comprising **Gerelt App** and **Gerelt Publishing**, this initiative has become the largest distributor of Christian e-books, audiobooks, and podcasts in Mongolia. The **Gerelt App** allows Mongolian believers across the globe to access Christian books on demand, providing a convenient and impactful way to engage with their faith.

As the global Mongolian community continues to grow, Gerelt drives the creation and accessibility of Christian educational resources, empowering believers and transforming lives across the world.



Along with the mobile platform, Gerelt hosts monthly live book podcasts to showcase books available for readers to enjoy. Host Oyungerel engages with guests in faith-driven discussions on topics such as finances, serving, inter-generational communication, and glorifying God.

In 2024, we live-streamed five episodes for Season 2, reaching and inspiring Mongolian listeners worldwide to continue learning and to know God.

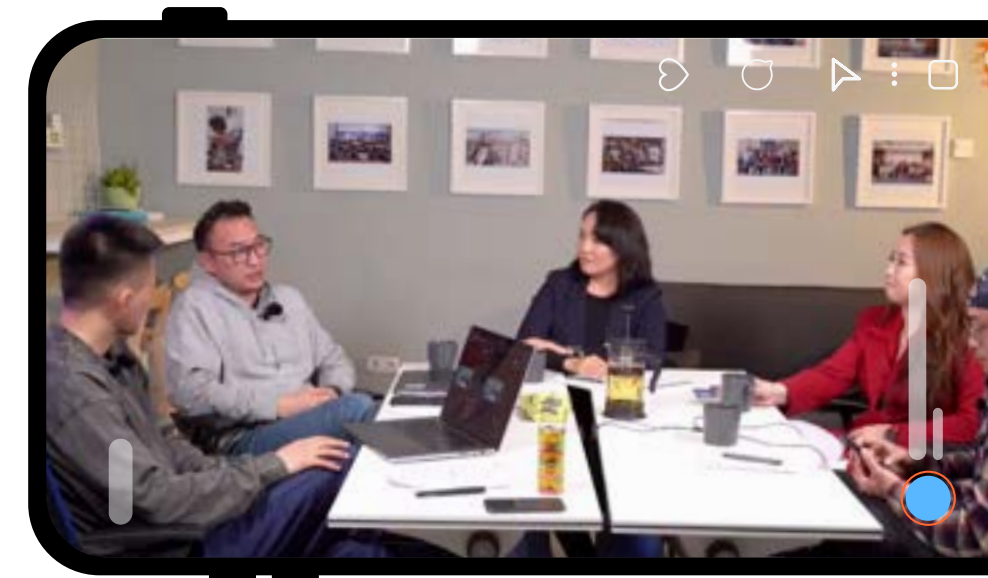

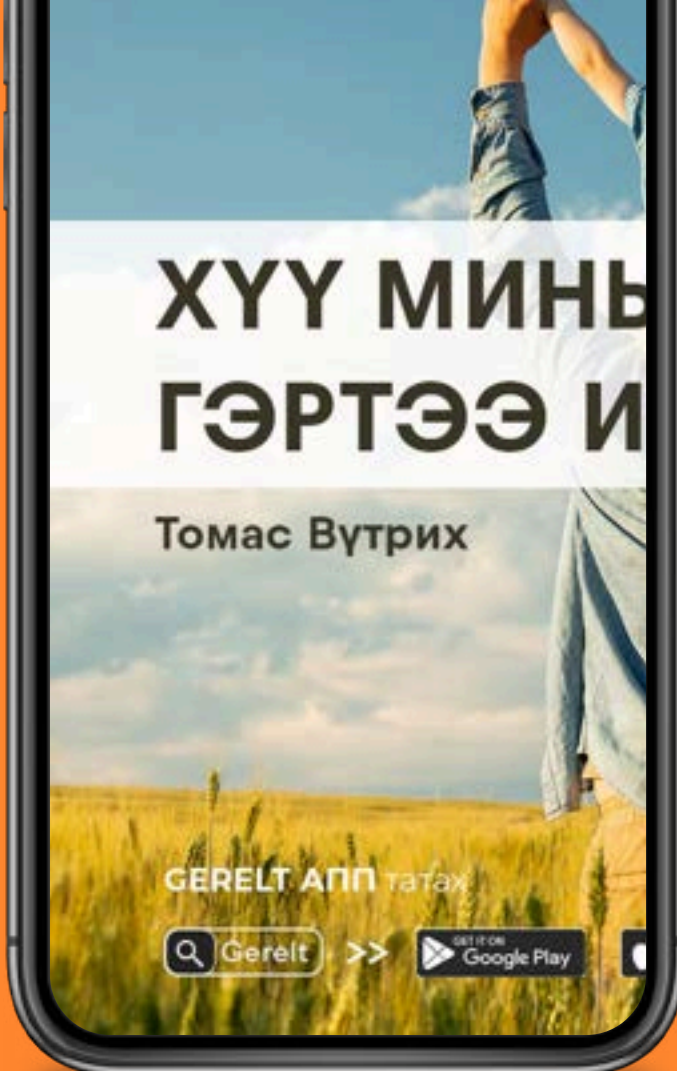

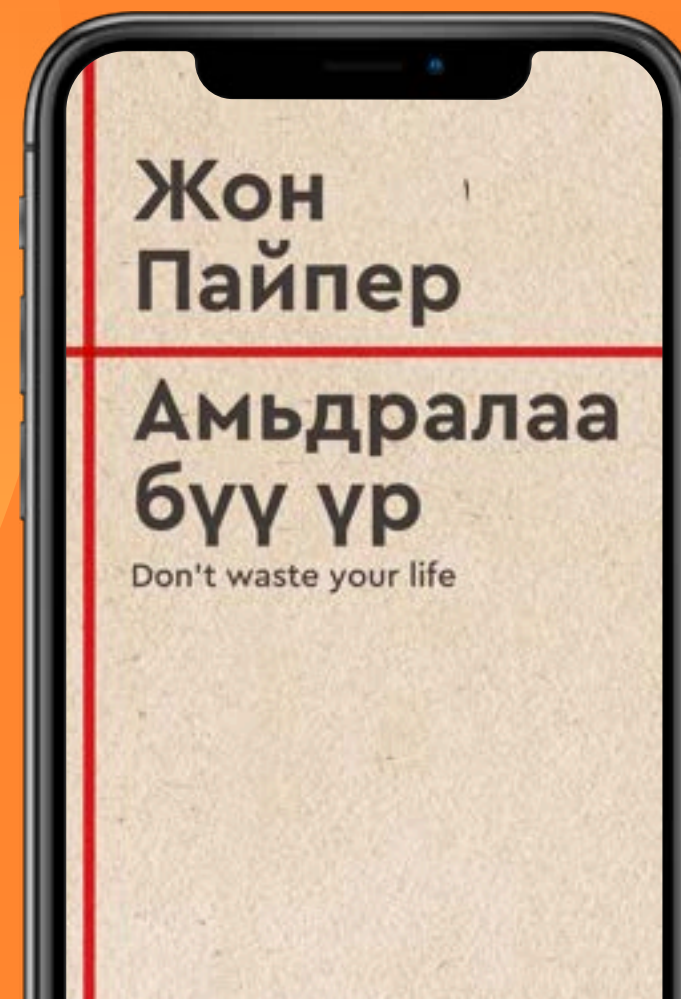

# FROM APP TO PUBLISHING

In August 2024, ALDN officially launched Gerelt Publishing, catalyzed by the growth of Gerelt App. This launch allows us to better serve Mongolian readers and also serve more stakeholders in the publishing industry.

Gerelt Publishing supports Christian authors and publishers by solving distribution challenges and connecting them with a global audience. This year, Gerelt Publishing successfully signed contracts and partnerships with global organizations like *9Marks*, *Desiring God* and others to translate and publish books, core articles, episodes and devotional materials.

In August, ALDN's partners at Cornerstone Publishing joined us in Mongolia to affirm the impact of the Gerelt App and affirm their continued investment that will also support Gerelt Publishing.

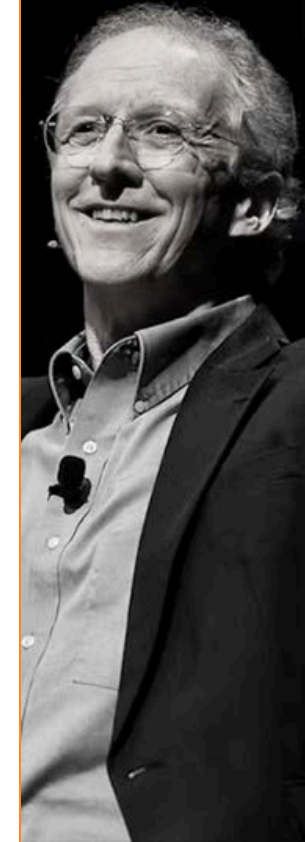

To equip the network of translators that ALDN is connected to, we organized two effective online trainings for 30 translators regarding Mongolian language grammar and quality of translation.

In 2024, Gerelt Publishing achieved a remarkable milestone with the translation and publication of four new titles by John Piper, a renowned author from *Desiring God*. This series—three books and the daily devotional *Solid Joys*—marks the first of Piper's works to be fully translated into Mongolian, filling a critical gap in spiritual formation resources.

To build momentum ahead of the launch, *Solid Joys* devotional content was shared electronically, reaching over 3,000 engaged followers on social media. The local launch in the autumn was a moment of celebration, as twelve churches received packages of twelve books to enrich their libraries and equip their congregations.
